Fundamental Axioms:

a. The Bible is the only authority regarding its own chronology.

b. In the transition from any segment to its successor within the main chronological line from Creation in 0 AM to the death of Messiah in 4033 AM, the last year touched by the segment is assigned to the segment in its entirety, and the next year becomes the succeeding segment's year 1. For example: if a king reigns until the 3rd month of year 2050, year 2050 becomes the last year of his reign, and year 2051 becomes the first year of his successor's reign.

21 CERTAIN CATACLYSM

- 25a <u>PROBABLE CATACLYSM Division of Earth</u>: The breakup of a single land mass into continents following the dispersion of people thoughout the earth explains the presence of people everywhere without resorting to land or ice bridges, fantastic voyages, etc.
- 27a <u>PROBABLE CATACLYSM Tower of Babel</u>: Construction of the city and the tower commenced immediately upon the Shemites arrival in Shinar (Sumeria) (Gen 10:10 & 11:2-4), near the beginning of Nimrod's reign he was a 3rd generation descendant of Noah (Gen 10:6-8) and thus a contemporary of Salah (Gen 10:22-24). Soon thereafter the Lord destroyed the tower and confounded the language with a blast (thunderbolt?) from heaven.

35 <u>Abraham's birth</u>: If Abraham was born when Terah had lived 70 years (Gen 11:26), then he left Haran 60 years before Terah died. If Abraham left Haran when Terah died, then he was born when Terah had lived 130 years. Acts 7:2-4 establishes the latter.

39 <u>430 Years</u>. Most chronologists begin the 430 years from the Covenant to the Law (Galatians 3:17) with the Promise (Gen 12:1-4), which occurred when Abraham was 75 years old, and which is often called "the initiation of the covenant." The word "covenant," however, is not used here and does not appear until Gen 15:18 in the midst of a description of Abraham's sacrifice and ensuing deep sleep, which is undated. The word "covenant" is used thirteen times in the description of Abraham's circumcision, which occurred when he was 99 years old, and therefore Panin begins the 430 years with the Circumcision. On the other hand, Paul uses the word "promise(s)" four times in his discussion of the covenant in Galatians 3:15-18). At the end of the day, I think Panin is right - the Covenant is intended as the start of the 430 years.

42 POSSIBLE CATACLYSM

42a CERTAIN CATACLYSM - Destruction of Sodom and Gomorrah: Gen 19:24-25

- 55 Joseph's birth: Jacob served Laban 7 years for Rachel, but got Leah instead. He then served Laban another 7 years for Rachel, at which point Joseph was born (Gen 30:25-26).. He then served Laban an additional 6 years for the cattle (Gen 29:20-30 & 31:41).
- 68 <u>Moses in Midian</u>: When Moses was 40, he fled from Egypt and entered Midian, which was separated from Egypt both geographically and socially, and in which Mount Sinai was located. The Sinai peninsula, where Mount Sinai is traditionally located, was part of Egypt. The region bordering the east coast of the Gulf of Aqaba, however, was not part of Egypt; it was part of Arabia. Moreover it contains a formidable mountain, Jabal al Lawz, whose physical characteristics and surrounding environment match the descriptions of Mount Sinai and its surrounding environment in Exodus, and the path to it from Ra's ash Shaykh Humayd, the landfall at the eastern side of the Straits of Tiran, passes by a major spring (the Springs of Marah?), the oasis at Al Bad (Elim?), and caves known locally as the Caves of Jethro (Moses' father-in-law).
- 70 <u>CERTAIN CATACLYSM Exodus</u>: Amidst the horrendous conditions of a natural cataclysm, and pursued by pharaoh, the Jews left Goshen and traveled down the west coast of the Sinai Peninsula bordering the Gulf of Suez, rounded the southern tip of the peninsula, and moved northeast to Pi-Ha-Khiroth, the land fall at the western side of the Strait of Tiran (the narrow opening between the Gulf of Aqaba and the Red Sea). When the shallow waters of the strait abated (possibly due to gale force winds sweeping down the Gulf of Aqaba from the north), they crossed over the natural causeway lying just beneath the strait's surface to Ra's ash Shaykh Humayd, the landfall at the eastern side of the strait. At that point, they had left Egypt and entered Midian (modern day Saudi Arabia). From Ra's ash Shaykh Humayd, they traveled first to the Springs of Marah, then to the oasis at Al Bad (or Elim) and then to Jabal al Lawz (or Mount Sinai). At that point, they met the Amalekites streaming out of Arabia toward
- 72 <u>Heshbon occupied for 300 Years</u>: Aaron died 40 years after the Exodus (Num 33:38). After mourning Aaron's death at Mount Hor (Num 20:22,28) for 30 days (Num 20:29), the Israelites jouneyed alongside the Red Sea, up around Edom (Num 21:4), and attacked the Amorites who had refused them passage (Num 21:23). They siezed a number of the Amorite cities, including Heshbon (Num 21:25). Later, when Jephthah confronted the Ammonite King after 18 years of Phillistine and Ammonite Oppression (Judges 10:7-8), he mentioned that Israel had occupied Heshbon for 300 years (Judges 11:26).
- 74a CERTAIN CATACLYSM Battle of Beth Horon
- 74c Joshua's Death
 - (a) Joshua's Death: Although the Bible indicates that Joshua lived 110 years (Genesis 50:26), it does not indicate the year in which he was born or the year in which he died. Josephus, however, indicates that Joshua led Israel for 25 years (Antiquities Vol. V, 1:29). Joshua began leading Israel when Moses died 40 years after the Exodus. If so, Joshua died 65 years after the Exodus, and thus he was born 45 years before the Exodus. All reasonable.
 - (b) <u>Break</u>: Within the 300 years of the Occupation of Heshbon, there is a break of 34 years between (1) the year in which Heshbon was taken (40 years after the Exodus) and (2) the commencement of Othniel's 40 Years of Rest, which occurred 266 years prior to the 300th year of Heshbon's occupation. 82c POSSIBLE CATACLYSM

104 <u>Samson's judgeship</u>: The Ark was returned to the Israelites at the end of the Phillistine/Ammonite Oppression after it had been in Kiriath Jearim for 20 years (1 Samuel 6:1, 7:2). That means that the Ark was taken, Eli died, and Samuel became High Priest 20 years before the end of the Phillistine/Ammonite Oppression. Since Samuel judged Israel all the days of his life (1 Samuel 7:15), his judgeship must have coincided with his High-Priesthood. That leaves exactly 20 years between the death of Abdon and the beginning of Samuel's judgeship - the precise length of time that Samson judged Israel during the time of the Phillistines (Judges 15:20).

- 108d <u>Saul's reign</u>: 1 Samuel 13:1 states clearly that Saul reigned 2 years. Panin argues persuasively that, since we know Saul reigned about 20 years, most of which was contemporaneous with Samuel's judgeship, the 2 years of 1 Samuel 13:1 must refer to the portion of his reign which followed Samuel's death. (As for Paul's statement in Acts 13:21 that God gave the Israelites Saul for 40 years the time of testing Panin argues that God cut that period short because Saul failed the testing.)

- 233 <u>Daniel led Return & Rebuilding of Temple</u>: Ezra identifies Sheshbazzar as "Prince of Judah" (Ezra 1:8) and the person into whose hands Cyrus committed the Temple vessels, and who then took them from Babylon to Jerusalem (Ezra 1:1, 5:14). Ezra also identifies Sheshbazzar as the person whom Cyrus appointed Governor (Ezra 5:14) and who laid the foundation of the Temple (Ezra 5:16). Since it was not uncommon for the consonants in ancient names to move i.e. Geshem = Gashmu Sheshbazzar is obviously a variant of Beltshazzar, the name given to Daniel by Nebuchadnezzar. That Daniel was the person to whom Cyrus entrusted the mission of transporting the temple treasures to Jerusalem and laying the foundations of the temple makes perfect sense.
- 245b Judgement on Jerusalem: Max Luna has pointed out that the "seven times" in Leviticus 26:18, 24, and 28 has been regarded by many as a specific prophecy concerning the duration of Jerusalem's subjection to the Gentiles (see The Number 7 in the Bible, pages 60-61). "Times" can be interpreted as a year of years. There were 360 days in the Hebrew year. Thus, a year of years is 360 years. Seven times a year of years (7 x 360) equals 2,520. Nebuchadnezzar sacked Jerusalem and removed most of its surviving inhabitants to Babylon in 3446 AM. Thus 5966 AM (3446+2520=5966) would be the date on which one would expect Jerusalem to be restored to Jewish
