- Comments:**
- 1 Five days before Passover would have been Friday - not the traditional date for the Procession with Palms.
 - 2 The women would have had all day Nisan 16 to buy spices after the Feast Day (Mk 16:1, here Nisan 15) and before the normal Sabbath (Lk 23:56, here Nisan 17).
 - 3 The resurrection would have occurred on the second day following the burial, violating Matthew 12:40, and two days before the women went to the tomb.
