10	Minor cataclysm <i>in Samuel’s time</i> that destroyed the Phillistine army.	1080	Mars	undated

14	Cataclysm <i>in Azariah’s time</i> that accompanied a third battle among planets in the sky, which DP calls the “Joel-Amos Catastrophe.” It caused the “Commotion in the Days of Uzziah (=Azariah),” ended Ovid’s Age of Iron, and marked the founding of Rome and the beginning of Ovid’s Age of Rome. It was <i>predicted by Amos, Joel, Jonah, &amp; Nahum</i> .	756	Mars	undated
