## MIGRATIONS PER THE TABLE OF THE NATIONS

This map shows the migrations originating in the Region of Ararat, which Samuel Shuckford<sup>1</sup> locates in “Saga Scythia on the hills beyond Bactria, north of India” – that is, in eastern Tadjikistan, at the northern end of the Hindu Kush, between the headwaters of the Oxus River (now Amu-Darya) to the northwest and the Indus River to the southeast, from which Noah’s descendants would have traveled westward to Shinar (Mesopotamia), as Genesis 11:2 maintains.
