

## SEVEN LAST SAYINGS OF CHRIST ON THE CROSS

### 1. The Word of Forgiveness

Then said Jesus, **“Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do”** (Luke 23:34).

### 2. The Word of Salvation

And [the dying thief] said unto Jesus, “Lord, remember me when Thou comest into Thy Kingdom.” And Jesus said unto him, **“Verily I say unto thee, Today shalt thou be with Me in Paradise”** (Luke 23: 42-43).

### 3. The Word of Affection

Now there stood by the cross of Jesus His mother. When Jesus therefore saw His mother, and the disciple standing by, whom He loved, He saith unto His mother, **“Woman, behold thy Son!”** Then saith He to the disciple, **“Behold thy mother!”** (John 19: 25-26).

### 4. The Word of Anguish

And about the ninth hour Jesus cried with a loud voice, Saying, **“Eli, Eli, lama sabachthani?”** - that is to say, **“My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken Me?”** (Matthew 27: 46).

### 5. The Word of Suffering

Jesus knowing that all things were now accomplished, that the Scripture might be fulfilled, saith, **“I thirst”** (John 19: 28).

### 6. The Word of Victory

When Jesus therefore had received the vinegar, He said, **“It is finished”** (John 19: 30).

### 7. The Word of Contentment

And when Jesus had cried with a loud voice, He said, **“Father, into thy hands I commend My spirit;”** and having said thus, He gave up His spirit (Luke 23: 46).
