(1) The only arrangement for Holy Week that the Bible will permit places the burial of the Messiah at the end of Passover (6:00 pm on a Wednesday) and the resurrection of Jesus at the end of a Sabbath (6:00 pm on a Saturday). Oddly, the algorithm for synchronizing the Jewish and Gregorian calendars, which I found on the internet, indicates that the end of Passover in April 33 AD fell, not on Wednesday, but on a Friday. Something here is wrong, but I have yet to determine what. JH.
