## TIMELINE OF MESSIAH'S LIFE

August 28, 2 BC (Tishri 1) - Messiah' Birth in Bethlehem occurred.
September 5, 2 BC (Tishri 9), Messiah's Circumcision occurred.
October 7, 2 BC, Messiah's Journey to Jerusalem, which occurred after His mother completed her ritual of 40 Days of Purification.
October 8, 2 BC - Messiah's (a) Dedication in the Temple and (b) Journey to Nazareth occurred.
December 25, 2 BC, Messiah's Visit of the Magi occurred.
January, 1 BC - Messiah's Flight to Egypt occurred.
August 28, 1 BC - Messiah's $\underline{1}^{\text {st }}$ Birthday occurred.
----------BC/AD----------
August 28, 1 AD - Messiah's $\underline{2}^{\text {nd }}$ Birthday occurred.
August 28, 11 AD - Messiah's $\mathbf{1 2}^{\text {th }}$ Birthday occurred..
March 23, 12 AD, Messiah's Discourse with the Elders in the Temple occurred..
Mid-August, 29 AD - Messiah' Baptism by John-the-Baptist occurred..
August 28, 29 AD - Messiah' $30^{\text {th }}$ Birthday occurred.
August 28 to October 7, 29 AD - Messiah’ 40 Days of Fasting in the wilderness occurred, at the end of which He was tempted by Satan.

October 7, 29 to October 7, 30 AD - Messiah' ${ }^{\text {st }}$ Year of Ministry (1.0 years) occurred.
March/April 30 AD - Messiah' $1^{\text {st }}$ Passover during His ministry occurred (John 2:11-13).
August 28, 30 AD - Messiah' $31^{\text {st }}$ Birthday occurred.
October 7, 30 to October 7, $\mathbf{3 1}$ AD - Messiah' $2^{\text {nd }}$ Year of Ministry ( 1.0 years) occurred.
March/April 31 AD - Messiah' $2^{\text {nd }}$ Passover during His ministry occurred (John 5:1).
August 28, 31 AD - Messiah' $32^{\text {nd }}$ Birthday occurred.
October 7, 31 AD to October 7, 32 AD - Messiah' $3^{\text {rd }}$ Year of Ministry ( 1.0 years) occurred.
March/April 33 AD - Messiah' $3^{\text {rd }}$ Passover during His ministry occurred (John 6:4).
August 28, 32 AD - Messiah' $33^{\text {rd }}$ Birthday occurred.
October 7, 32 to early April 33 AD - Messiah' $4^{\text {th }}$ Year of Ministry ( 0.5 years) occurred. ${ }^{1}$
Early April 33 AD - Messiah' $4^{\text {th }}$ Passover during His ministry occurred (John $11: 55$ \& 12:1), on which He, the Lamb of God, (a) was arrested by priests and guards of the Temple and some Jewish Elders, (b) tried by the Sanhedrin, (c) defamed by false-witnesses, (d) interviewed by

[^0]Pontius Pilate, (e) mocked by King Herod and his men, (f) returned to Pilate, where He was rejected by His people in favor of the criminal Barabbas, (g) condemned by Pilate, (h) turned over to Roman soldiers, who tortured Him for hours and then crucified Him, (i) suffered six hours of agony and humiliation hanging on a cross at Golgotha, just outside Jerusalem's Damascus Gate, (j) relinquished His life, and (k) was buried by His followers in the Tomb of Joseph of Arimathea, after which the Roman cohort sealed the tomb at about 5:55 pm and then guarded it around the clock to prevent anyone from tampering with the body.
On the $1^{\text {st }}$ Sabbath following His burial - Messiah's Resurrection occurred about 5:55 pm.
On the $1^{\text {st }}$ day following His resurrection - i.e. a Sunday - early in the morning, some women discovered that the tomb was empty and learned from two angels that Messiah had risen.
On the $\mathbf{4 0}^{\text {th }}$ day following His resurrection - i.e. a Thursday - Messiah's Ascension to Heaven occurred.
On the $5 \mathbf{5 0}^{\text {th }}$ day following His resurrection - i.e. a Sunday - Pentecost Sunday occurred.


[^0]:    ${ }^{1}$ This brings the length of Messiah's ministry to 3.5 years (early in October 29 AD to early in April 33 AD), which conforms with the first half of Daniels' $70^{\text {th }}$ Week of Years, which lasts 3.5 days of years $=3.5$ years (Daniel 9:2427).
