## ---CREATION (3977 BC)------ERA 1 - THE EDENIC WORLD ( 3977 BC)---

ANCIENT PATRIARCHS (AP) (3977-1894 BC), of which less than 1 year ( $\mathbf{3 9 7 7} \mathbf{B C}$ ) fell in this period.

- Adam (gen 1, AP-1), a son of God, was created in 3977 BC. He lived 930 years (39773047 BC), of which less than 1 year ( 3977 BC) fell in this period. He was known in Babylon as Alorus.
- The Adam Disturbance in 3977 BC.
---ERA 2 - ANTEDILUVIAN WORLD (3977-2321 BC)---


## ANCIENT PATRIARCHS (AP) (3977-2321 BC), of which more than 1655 plus years

 (3977-2321 BC) fell in this period.- Adam (gen 1, AP-1) continued - He lived 930 years (3977-3047 BC), of which 929 plus years (3977-2321 BC) fell in this period). He was known in Babylon as Alorus.
- Seth (gen 2, AP-2) , a son of Adam, was born in 3847 BC, when his father was 130 years old. He lived 912 years (3847-2935 BC). He was known in Babylon as Alasparus.
- Enos (gen 3, AP-3), a son of Seth, was born in 3742 BC, when his father was 105 years old. He lived 905 years (3742-2837 BC). He was known in Babylon as Amelon.
- Cainan (gen 4, AP-4), a son of Enos, was born in 3652 BC, when his father was 90 years old. He lived 910 years (3652-2742 BC). He was known in Babylon as Amenon.
- Mahalaleel (gen 5- AP-5), a son of Cainan, was born in 3582 BC, when his father was 70 years old. He lived 895 years (3582-2687 BC). He was known in Babylon as Metalarus,
- Jared (gen 6, AP-6), a son of Mahalaleel, was born in 3517 BC, when his father was 65 years old. He lived 962 years ( $3517-2555$ BC). He was known in Babylon as Daorus.
- Enoch (gen 7, AP-7), a son of Jared, was born in 3355 BC, when his father was 162 years old. He lived 365 years ( $3355-2990$ BC). He was known in Babylon as Aedorachus. Because he walked with God he did not die, but rather was taken or "translated" by God.
- Methuselah (gen 8, AP08), a son of Enoch, was born in 3290 BC, when his father was 65 years old. He lived 969 years (3290-2321 BC). He was known in Babylon as Amphis.
- Lamech (gen 9, AP-9), a son of Methuselah, was born in 3103 BC, when his father was 187 years old. He lived 777 years (3103-2326 BC). He was known in Babylon as Oliartes.
- Noah (gen 10, AP-10), a son of Lamech, was born in 2921 BC, when his father was 182 years old. He lived 950 years (2921-1971 BC), of which 600 years (2921-2321 BC) fell in this period. He was known in Babylon as Xisuthrus and in China as Nuwa and Fohi. With the help of his three sons, Japheth (b. 2421 BC), Shem (b. 2419 BC), and Ham (b. unknown), he built the ark to survive the global flood, which began in 2321 BC , when he was 600 years old.
- Japheth (gen 11), Noah's oldest son (Genesis 10:21)..
- Shem (gen 11, AP-11), Noah's middle son, was born in 2419 BC, when his father was 502 years old. He lived for 600 years ( $2419-1819 \mathrm{BC}$ ), of which 98 years (2419-2321 BC) fell in this period. He was the last of the Antediluvian patriarchs.
- Ham (gen 11) - Noah's youngest son.
- The Noah Disturbance in 2321 BC.

## ANCIENT PATRIARCHS (AP) (3977-1894 BC), of which 100 years (2321-2221 BC) fell in

 this period.- Noah (gen 10, AP-10) continued - He lived 950 years (2921-1971 BC), of which 100 years (2321-2221 BC) fell in this period.
- Japheth (gen 11) continued - He probably lived throughout this period.
- Shem (gen 11, AP-11) continued - He lived for 600 years (2419-1819 BC), of which 100 years (2321-2221 BC) fell in this period.
- Ham (gen 11) continued - He probably lived throughout this period.
- Arphaxad (gen 12, AP-12), a son of Shem, was born in 2319 BC, when his father was 100 years old. He lived for 438 years (2319-1881 BC), of which 98 years (2319-2221 $\mathrm{BC})$ fell in this period. He is the first of the Postdiluvian patriarchs.
- Cush (gen 12) - Ham's son, who was also known as Ukusi, the first ruler of Babylon's $1^{\text {st }}$ Dynasty.
- Selah (gen 13, AP-13), a son of Arphaxad, was born in 2284 BC, when his father was 35 years old. He lived 433 years ( $2284-1851 \mathrm{BC}$ ), of which 63 years ( $2284-2221 \mathrm{BC}$ ) fell in the period.
- Nimrod (gen 13) - Cush's son, who was also known as Azag, the second ruler of Babylon's $1^{\text {st }}$ Dynasty. He established a kingdom in Shinar (=Mesopotamia), building the cities of Babel (=Babylon), Erech, Accad, and Calneh (Genesis 10:10).
- Eber (gen 14, AP-14), a son of Selah, was born in 2254 BC, when his father was 30 years old. He lived 464 years (2254-1790 BC).
- The Peleg Disturbance in 2221 BC.

- Peleg (gen 15, AP-15), a son of Eber, was born in 2220 BC, when his father was 34 years old. He lived 239 years ( $2220-1981 \mathrm{BC}$ ), of which the first 151 years ( $2221-2070 \mathrm{BC}$ ) fell in this period. The land was divided in 2221 BC , when he was in his mother's womb.
- Reu (gen 16, AP-16), a son of Peleg, was born in 2190 BC, when his father was 30 years old. He lived 239 years ( $2190-1951 \mathrm{BC}$ ), of which the first 120 years ( $2190-2070 \mathrm{BC}$ ) fell in this period.
- Serug (gen 17, AP-17), a son of Reu, was born in 2158 BC, when his father was 32 years old. He lived 230 years ( $2158-1928 \mathrm{BC}$ ), of which the first 88 years ( $2158-2070 \mathrm{BC}$ ) fell in this period.
- Nahor (gen 18, AP-18), a son of Serug, was born in 2128 BC, when his father was 30 years old. He lived 148 years (2128-2000 BC), of which 58 years (2128-2070 BC) fell in this period.
- Terah (gen 19, AP-19), a son of Nahor, was born in 2099 BC, when his father was 29 years old. He lived 205 years (2099-1894 BC), of which the first 29 years (2099-2070 BC) fell in this period. He was the last of the ancient patriarchs.

- Eber (gen 14, AP-14) continued - He lived 464 years (2254-1790 BC), of which 200 years (2070-1870 BC) years fell in this period.
- Peleg (gen 15, AP-15) continued - He lived 239 years (2220-1981 BC), of which the last 89 years (2070-1981 BC) fell in this period.
- Reu (gen 16, AP-16) continue - He lived 239 years (2190-1951 BC), of which 119 years (2070-1951 BC) fell in this period.
- Serug (gen 17, AP-17) continued - He lived 230 years (2158-1928 BC), of which the last 142 years (2070-1928 BC) fell in this period.
- Nahor (gen 18, AP-18) continued - He lived 148 years (2128-2000 BC), of which the last 70 years ( $2070-2000 \mathrm{BC}$ ) fell in this period.
- Terah (gen 19, AP-19) continued - He lived 205 years (2099-1894 BC), of which the last 176 years (2070-1894 BC) fell in this period.


## HEBREW PATRIARCHS (HP) (1894-1608 BC), of which 24 years (1894-1870 BC) fell in this period.

- Abraham (gen 20, HP-1), a son of Terah, was born in 1969 BC, when his father was 130 years old. He lived 175 years (1969-1794 BC). He was the first of the Hebrew patriarchs.
- The Abraham Disturbance in 1870 BC.

HEBREW PATRIARCHS (HP) (1894-1608 BC), of which 203 years (1870-1667 BC) fell in this period.
- Shem (gen 11, AP-11) continued - He lived for 600 years (2419-1819 BC), of which the last 51 years ( $1870-1819 \mathrm{BC}$ ) fell in this period.
- Eber (gen 14, AP-14) continued - He lived 464 years (2254-1790 BC), of which the last 80 years (1870-1790 BC) years fell in this period.
- Abraham (gen 20, HP-1) continued - He lived 175 years (1969-1794 BC), of which the last 76 years ( $1870-1794 \mathrm{BC}$ ) fell in this period.
- Isaac (gen 21, HP-2), a son of Abraham, was born in 1870 BC, when his father Abraham was 99 years old. He lived 180 years (1870-1690 BC).
- Jacob (gen 22, HP-3), a son of Isaac, was born in 1809 BC, when his father was 61 years old. He lived 147 years ( $1809-1662$ BC), of which the first 142 years ( $1809-1667$ BC).
- Joseph (gen 23, HP-4), a son of Jacob, was born in 1718 BC, when his father was 91 years old. He lived 110 years (1718-1608 BC), of which the first 51 years (1718-1667 $\mathrm{BC})$ fell in this period. He was the last of the Hebrew patriarchs.
--- Period 3B-2 - The Post-Job Time (1667-1464 BC)---
HEBREW PATRIARCHS (HP) (1894-1608 BC), of which 59 years (1667-1608 BC) fell in this period.
- Jacob (gen 22, HP-3) continued - He lived 147 years (1809-1662 BC), of which the last 5 years (1667-1662 BC).
- Joseph (gen 23, HP-4) continued - He lived 110 years (1718-1608 BC), of which the last 59 years ( $1667-1608 \mathrm{BC}$ ) fell in this period.
HIATUS in leadership lasted 144 years (1608-1464 BC).
