1A - THE EALY PREHISTORIC ERA 1A-0 - Creation (3977 BC)

<u>BABYLON'S DEMI-GODS ¹ (3977 BC)</u>, of which less than 1 year (3977 BC) fell in this period.

- (B0-01) Alorus The Hebrews called him Adam who lived 930 years (3977-3047 BC), of which a few days or weeks fell in this period.

- (B0-09) Oliartes The Hebrews called him Lamech, who lived 777 years (3103-2326 BC).
- (B0-10) Xisuthrus The Hebrews called him Noah, who lived 950 years (2921-1971 BC), the first 600 years (2921-2321 BC) of which fell in this period.

¹ The figures associated with the Babylonian demi-gods vary. The average is roughly 43,000 plus. If they are presumed to be years, they bear no discernable relationship to the biblical ages of the pre-flood patriarchs, the average of which is 881 years. Nonetheless I am curious concerning their possible source. There is certainly abundant evidence that many ancient people used a 360-day calendar for centuries: Assyrians, Babylonians, Chaldeans, China, Egyptians, Greeks, Hebrews, Hindus, Mayas, Persians, Polynesians, and Romans. Moreover there is evidence that the lunar month changed several times during this time from 30 days to 36 days, and then to 29.5 days - the last coinciding with the change of the year from 360 days to 365..25 days c.754 BC. Most scientists and scholars regard these figures as evidence of primitive minds, unable to measure the movement of the heavenly bodies accurately - not as evidence of past changes in the solar system., even though their recorded observations were quite precise.

BABYLON'S 1ST DYNASTY (B1) (3221-? BC), of which 151 years (2221-2270 BC) fell in this period.

- (B1-03) Khetm continued He reigned for 7 years (2226-2219 BC), the last two years (2221-2219 BC) of which fell in this period He was also known as Dukh, Tukh, and Vri-taka.

- (B1-05) Zagissi, who was a usurper He reigned for 25 years (2211-2186 BC).

- (B1-08) Mannis-tusu, who was Rimush's younger brother He reigned for 15 years (2119-2104 BC). He was also known in Egypt as (EPD-05 & E01-01) Ahamen, Hor-aha, and Menes and in the Indus Valley as Aha-manj, Asa-manja and Manasyu. He was a mighty warrior.
- (B1-09) Naram-Sin, who was Mannis-tusu's son He reigned for 57 years (2104-2047 BC), the first 34 years (2104-2070 BC) of which fell in this period. He was also known in Egypt as (E01-02) Athothis I, Djer, Kourodes, Narmer, and Zer-ta.
- The *Terah Disturbance* in 2070 BC.

<u>NEO-BABYLONIAN DYNASTY (NB) (647-487 BC)</u>, of which both Babylonian and Chaldean (so-called Hittite) records exist.

- <u>Shamash-shum-ukin (NB-01)</u> ruled Babylon for an unknown number of years (647-603 BC) He was also known as Suppiluliuma II,
- <u>Nabopolassar II (NB-02)</u> ruled Babylon for 22 years (c.603-581 BC) He was also known as Mursilis, Bel-shum-ishkun, Belesys, and possibly Candalanus,
- Nergilissar (NB-3) ruled Babylon for 7 years (c.581-574 BC) He was also known as Nergil I, Muwatalis I, and Labarnas,
- Labash Marduk I (NB-04) ruled Babylon for less than a year (547 BC).
- <u>Nebuchadnezzar (NB-05)</u> ruled Babylon for 44 years (574-530 BC) He was also known as Hattusilis, In year 37 of his reign, he gave his daughter Kilus-Hepa=Maathorneferure in marriage to Ramses II II=Necho II.
- <u>Amel Marduk (NB-06)</u>, who was also known as Evil-Marduk in the Bible, ruled Babylon for 21 years (530-509 BC).
- Nergilissar II (NB-07) ruled Babylon for 4 years (509-504 BC) He was also known as Nergil II,
- **Labash Marduk II (NB-08)** ruled Babylon for less than 1 year (504 BC).
- <u>Nabonidus (NB-09)</u> ruled Babylon for 17 years (504-487 BC), during the last 14 years (501-487 BC) of which his coregent was **Belshazzar**.
